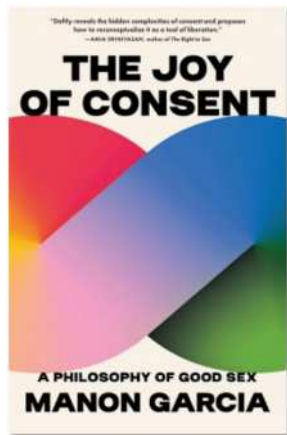
Progress and Regression
